

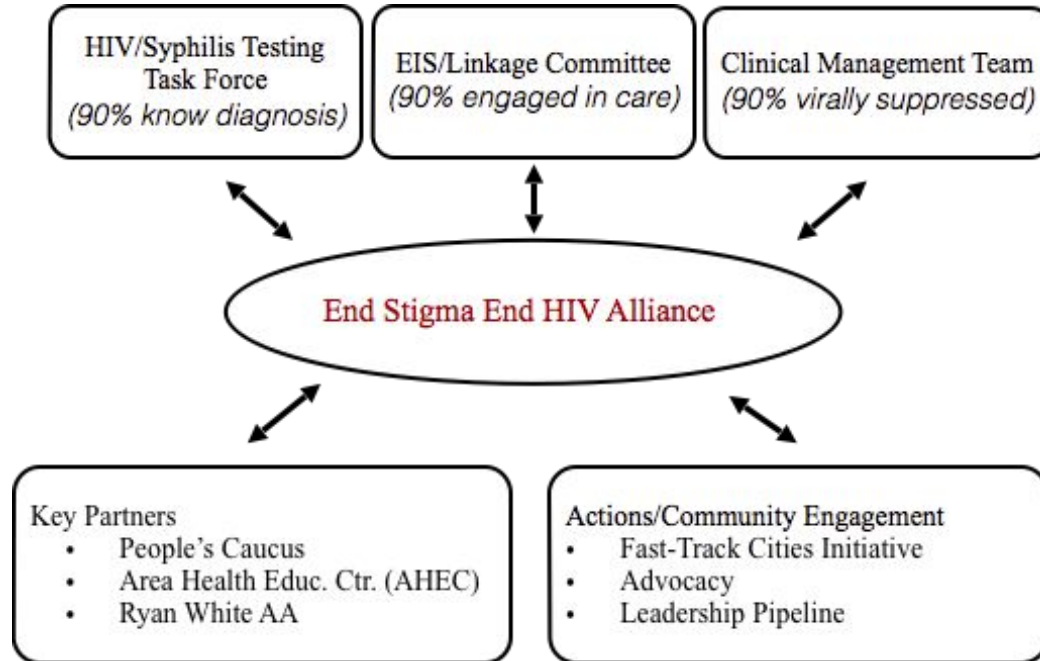

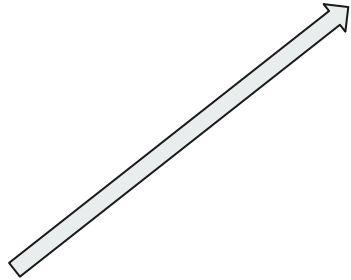


# Progress/Strategy

## End AIDS by 2030



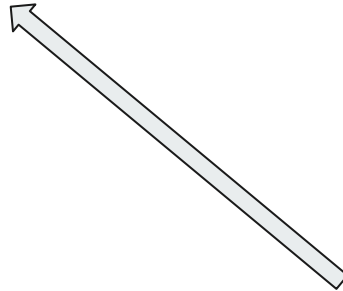
Goal: 90% Diagnosed

# 90% Undetectable: Using the same metrics



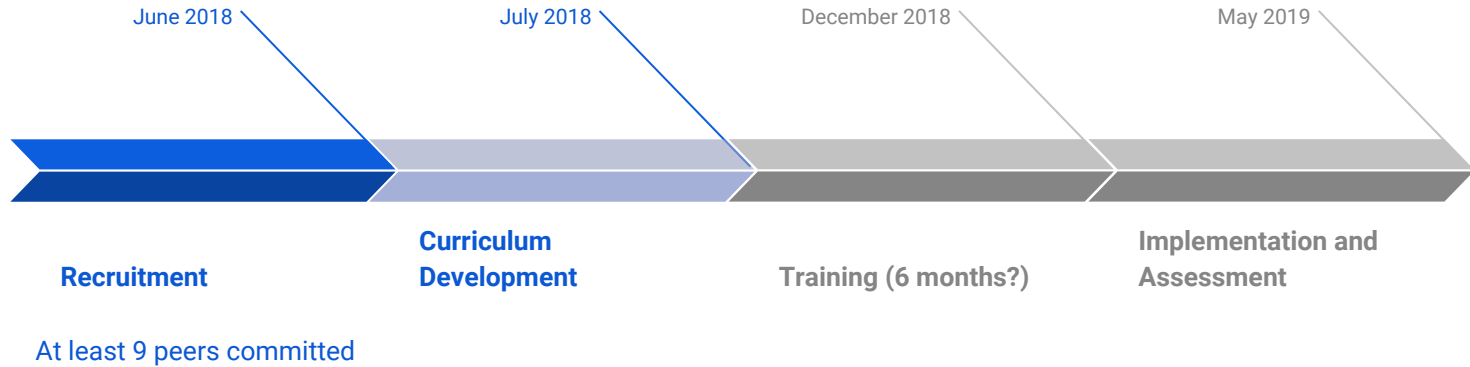
*HIV providers will start reporting quarterly:*

- 1. Patients with undetectable viral load*
- 2. Patients with viral load < 200*

*Instead of “virally suppressed”*
